This master is accredited and financed by the European Commission under the framework of the Erasmus+ project. Tuition language is English and we recruit international student around the world. (23 different nationalities for the first intake). This sponsorship allow us to offer very competitive student scholarships (up to 49,000 EUR for Malaysian nationals) and finance teaching and research exchanges, which could be a good starting point for further a cooperation (namely to welcome as an associate partner to a Malaysian HEI). We would like to recruit best Malaysian undergraduate students (entry requirements are academic background in physics/math or computer science or ideally a combination of both fields).

3. Increase students mobility (both outgoing and incoming) within the framework of our international master's degree (taught in English). We would like to increase our partnership base to allow our best international students to join for a semester Malaysian HEIs. Conversely, we will be happy to welcome Malaysian students for a semester or an academic year in these programmes (mobility could be financed by Erasmus+ programme).

Candidates conduct their research under the oversight of, and with guidance from, a dissertation adviser from each of the 2 countries involved in the program.
